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Policies

Payment:

- Private tours are \$200.00 per 1 hour **PLUS** the cost of admissions to the Haida Gwaii Museum. There is no tax on the private tour but there is 5% GST on the admission fee.
- To confirm your tour booking there is a **non-refundable** deposit of \$100.00
- The Haida Heritage Centre requires that the remaining balance be paid on the day of your tour.

Private Tours:

- Private Tours are a minimum of 1 hour.
- Please ensure you are at least 15 minutes early. If you are going to be late, please call ahead or the tour will start without you.
- We have 3 private tours available:
 - Monumental Pole Tour - will cover the background of the Haida Heritage Centre and Haida Gwaii Museum, the K'uuna Pole in the Welcome House, 6 poles outside, Carving House, Display Model, and Lootaa.
 - The Museum Tour - will walk you through the Temporary Gallery (if available), take you through the Supernatural Room, explain the rising of the water levels, a quick overview of the timeline, talk about the weaving and argillite collection and discuss the Skidegate Haida Immersion Programs, along with many topics that will be brought up during the discussions.
 - The Monumental Pole and Weaving Tour - will cover the Display Model, Bill Reid's Pole, the 6 Poles outside and then the Weaving (Exhibit). This will cover the background of the cedar and spruce trees, how materials are harvested, and different weaving methods like baskets, hats, mats and blankets.



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How to Conduct Yourself and/or Your Group using the 4 Haida Laws

We the Haida people live and abide by the 4 Haida Laws and we ask you, our visitor to conduct yourselves in the same matter while visiting us and Haida Gwaii.

Yahguudang (Respect)

All acts must be done with respect

Respect the space – The Haida Heritage Centre is on the ancestral village site of Kay Llnagaay – Sealion Town.

Respect the people – The Haida Heritage Centre staff are all Haida and knowledgeable about their history.

Ad Kyaanang (To ask first)

All acts must be done with consent

Any questions regarding Haida culture, people or the Haida Heritage Centre, please feel free to ask at any time.

Tllyahda (Make it right)

If an act is not done with respect or consent, or is witnessed, you must make it right.

Inappropriate behaviour or not following the rules, our Haida Ambassadors have the right to ask you/them to leave.
